The Alumni Conference is the culminating activity of the Dialogue on Innovative Higher Education Strategies – International Deans' Course Latin America (DIES IDC LA), jointly organised by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), the German Rectors' Conference (HRK), Saarland University (Germany), and the University of Alicante (Spain). The Alumni Conference is an annual alumni meeting held by the end of Module IV in a partner institution in Latin America to strengthen networking among the DIES IDC LA Alumni and to analyse the main problems and challenges in Higher Education. The agenda of the event is still to be determined and you will receive further notifications in this regard in the future.

Registration & Confirmation of Participation

Participation in this event is free of charge for Alumni, yet attendees are required to register themselves by completing the *Alumni Conference 2024 – Registration Form*.

The deadline for registration to attend the event is **23 February 2024 at 23:59 CET**. After this date, registrations will not be accepted.

The Alumni Conference 2024 will be focused on three main topics as indicated below. The extent to which the event will deal with one or the other topic will depend on the abstracts/proposals received.

- Sustainable Development
- Internationalisation
- Opportunities in Online Teaching

Funding

Participation for Alumni is <u>free of charge</u>. Due to the voluntary nature of this event, the DIES IDC LA Alumni will be in charge of their expenses for the complete duration of the event. For this reason, **Alumni should be able to cover the following expenses**:

- Travel costs: local transportation in the Alumnus/a's own country, outward and return flights
 within Latin America, as well as costs arising from required ground transportation in the
 destination country.
- Accommodation.
- Private meals during the given period.
 - △ Joint meals with the DIES IDC LA Team and other Alumni (Alumni Dinner and catering services) will be covered for all Alumni attending the event.
- Emergency health insurance and/or travel insurance. The Alumnus/a is strongly encouraged to contract their own health insurance during the given period.

Additional costs due to extended stays will not be covered. In the event of an Alumnus/a being unable to travel, **cancellation costs incurred will not be reimbursed**. This includes cancellations due to health safety travel restrictions.
